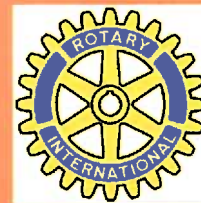
This year's Cycle Challenge is on 1st November and the launch will be on 19th October. We will need people to volunteer for jobs soon.
