This year the focus is on dementia care and the exchange will be between Tasmania and Germany. ( Dusseldorf) Both groups will visit aged care centres, service providers, universities and research facilities as well as combining this with local travel and fellowship.

Tasmania is actually at the forefront of dementia research (must be all those ageing Rotarians) and our visitors will visit the Wicking Dementia Research Centre at UTas and the Menzies Centre as part of their exchange.
